### Sevenoaks Town Council encourages residents to engage with the Kent Wildlife Trust's longterm plans for its visitor centre at Sevenoaks.

During the Neighbourhood Development Plan consultation there was considerable interest in the Sevenoaks Wildlife reserve and its future plans. Members of the public informed the Town Council that it wanted to see a 'circular walk' around the main lake, access from Otford Road and general improvements to the facilities and entrance.

Sevenoaks Town Council were provided with a presentation by Kent Wildlife Trust last week and was pleased to learn that the creation of the 'circular walk' was completed and that it was holding a consultation on its long-term plans. The Town Council would encourage all residents to engage in the process – please see details below.
