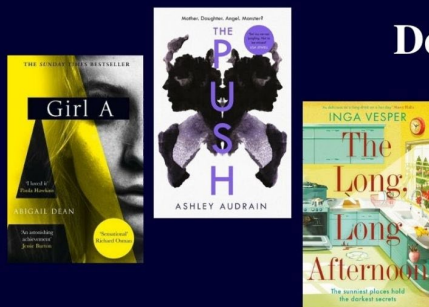
# Author Events in March
