## **Sevenoaks Town Council invites grant applications from the local community**

### **Do you need extra funding to help with voluntary projects within Sevenoaks Town?**

Sevenoaks Town Council, through its Finance and General Purposes Committee, offers grants to local voluntary or charitable organisations which provide services to residents within the Parish of Sevenoaks Town. Through its Youth Services Committee, the Council also offers funding for youth activities.

#### **Aims of Grant Scheme**

- To encourage and support the activities of voluntary or charitable organisations within Sevenoaks Town
- To promote new community initiatives where real additional benefits are offered to the community

#### **Who can apply?**

Organisations:

- which provide services that will directly benefit the area and residents of Sevenoaks Town wards: Town, Kippington, St Johns, Eastern, Wildernessee and Northern
- that are independently established for charitable, benevolent or philanthropic purposes
- which have a written document setting out aims and objectives

#### **Deadline for applications**

The Town Council will next consider applications for youth grant funding at its Youth Services Committee on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2021 and general applications at its Finance and General Purposes Committee on 13<sup>th</sup> September 2021.

**The deadline for applications is Friday 13th August 2021**

# Can you help us develop our draft strategy for adult social care in Kent?

Following on from our early discussion workshops at the beginning of the year with members of the public, we'd like to carry on the conversation and ask **what's important to people we support, families, carers and our partners in adult social care.**

## How will my views be taken forward?

These are co-production workshops, and your thoughts will contribute to the initial development of a draft five year strategy for adult social care.

## Is this a public consultation?

No, not yet. We want to get people involved as early as possible. This work is at its development stage, so that our stakeholders have the opportunity to test and shape our thinking. There will be a consultation later this year.

## Who should attend?

We'd like to hear from people from all backgrounds in Kent aged 18 and over. Workshops are also open to members of community groups
