8. Christmas Lights Switch On

Although a successful event with thousands of people enjoying the Christmas Lights Switch On, the 2023 event was marred by some antisocial behaviour which took place at and



around The Vine. This took the form of large numbers of young people misbehaving, many being intoxicated by drink or drugs.

As a result, and in an effort to mitigate the chances of this happening again it is likely that the event in 2024 will take place on a Saturday afternoon, subject to all the necessary arrangements being feasible.

9. Childrens Christmas High Street Safari

This was a very successful event with 300 people taking part. It was sponsored by Budare with the lucky dip prize of £100 meal voucher being donated by Giggling Squid and the presentation to the winning Bolton family being made by Mayor Cllr Claire Shea. A pleasing aspect was that there were a good number of new businesses wishing to take part.

This took place on Friday 8th December. The entertainment and catering arrangements were far better than in the inaugural 2022 event. Numbers were fewer than expected, but attendees all had a really great time and word will spread for 2024. It was noticeable that while the target audience was businesses, the event attracted about an equal number of "social club" guests.

12. New Town Team website

At the December Board meeting the discussion about a new site continued, with the general consensus being that it would need BID funding to make the project viable. It was suggested that a discussion with SDC be held to see if Visit Sevenoaks and More Sevenoaks could be used/shared.

That discussion has been held with both parties happy to work along these lines. The SDC sites have an automated functionality which is what would be really needed to drive the new TT site, but it is not being used presently. TT is now starting to send material to SDC for uploading.

SDC is also introducing literature stands to supermarkets and public buildings etc and has invited TT/STC to provide printed leaflets.


Meanwhile a presentation by Loqiva <u>Home - Loqiva</u> <u>Your Digital Town Hub</u> has been given and this opens up a different range of opportunities as it is an app, where instead of waiting for a user to access a website for information it is sent by push messages to those people who have registered an interest in a subject. It is a highly flexible tool. Including notifications from the public to councils and utilities about street repairs, bins etc, going direct to relevant departments, and a raft of footfall stats, it has far too many functions to be described here.
